We're pleased to share that schools across the Local Authority have now started using a new School Management Information System: ARBOR. This change will help us improve how we communicate and share important information with you.

As part of this rollout, we will be introducing a new email & text messaging service next half-term, making it easier for us to keep in touch with you quickly and efficiently.

Looking ahead to the New Year, we're excited to launch a **Parent App** that will integrate directly with our school systems. This app will allow you to:

- Receive school communications instantly
- Access key information about your child
- Stay up to date with school events and notices

We believe this will be a fantastic development for our whole school community, helping us stay connected and informed.

Personalised Assessments / SELFIE Tests



Numeracy (Procedural/Reasoning) and **Reading** personalised assessments are available throughout the year for schools to use to support Year 2 to Yr 6 learners to make progress.

Personalised assessments: information for parents and carers - Hwb (gov.wales)

We will be administering the personalised assessments during class lessons from 3rd November until 21st November.

After learners have completed these, we will have access to their feedback on learners' skills, progress and age-standardised scores to help plan teaching and learning.

Teachers will wait until later in the school year to discuss how your child is progressing based on feedback from one or more assessments and their observations of their learning.

During this assessment window we will also be carrying out our annual SELFIE [Year 1 to 6] and non-verbal assessments [Reception to Year 6].
