Reform of the school year

Governments across the world are looking at the rhythm of the school year to see whether changes can help avoid children "losing" learning during long holidays, ensure a better recovery from the effects of the pandemic and create a structure that works better for teachers and school staff.

Will a change better align with working / family patterns and provide greater opportunities for young people? Will change have an effect on other sectors of the economy and public services, and how could changes help improve learner wellbeing and confidence, and improve recruitment and retention within the school workforce?

The Welsh Government is currently engaging with stakeholders including the education workforce, non-education stakeholders such as employers, specific industries (e.g. tourism) and also children and young people to gather thoughts, ideas and opinions.

One key element of this research and engagement stage are **online surveys** – one for the **education workforce** and one for **young people** (under 18). The more people who have their say, the better the range of ideas and the stronger the research and engagement will be
