Our topics this term will be 'Cynefin' – Me and My Community and Exploring Autumn.

In Literacy we will be learning- Sound recognition, letter formation, identifying initial sounds in words, building simple cvc words such as cat, hat, pig. The story of 'The Three Little Pigs. We will be identifying and writing our names using the correct letter formation

In Maths we will be learning – Counting to 10, 20 and 100; Recognising numbers to 5, 10 then 20; writing numbers to 5, 10 then 20; recognising simple 2d and 3d shapes; creating repeating patterns using colours and shape. We will be comparing sizes and sharing out objects equally.

In ICT we will be learning about - E-safety, simple programming of floor robots, correct use of i-pads and equipment.

Through our topic we will be talking about our families and comparing them to others, writing the names of people who live in our houses and discussing people and objects that are special to us including our friends and how we can be a good friend. We will be ordering different times of the day and finding out about different shades of colours including the colours of Autumn and how seasons change. We will also be learning about nocturnal animals, wild and woodland animals and comparing their features. We will be finding out about and celebrating different festivals throughout the Autumn Term.



How you can help your child at home...

- Sounding out and writing cvc words such as cat, dog, hat.
- Practicing their high frequency words that are sent home.
- Name writing including surname with correct letter formation and pencil grip.
- Sharing their reading books at home on a weekly basis. Please record this in their reading record.
- Reading and writing numbers with correct formation.
- Dressing and undressing themselves including doing up their coat and shoes.
- Practising their Maths Learn-its.



Things we need this term:

Reinforcement of sounds and numbers learnt at school through exploration in the local environment eg shape hunt, looking at shop signs and house numbers around the local area.

All clothes and personal belongings to be clearly labelled.

Water bottles to be brought in every day, labelled and please do not put them in their green book bags.


