Our topic this term will be Celebrations

Health and Well Being – keeping myself healthy at school, healthy eating, becoming more independent in my classroom. Being a good friend, 'kind hands, kind feet, kind words.'

Language, Literacy and Communication - Sound recognition, letter formation, identifying initial sounds in words. Learning to read cvc words. Greetings, counting to ten, colours in Welsh through songs and rhymes.

In Mathematics and Numeracy we will be learning – To practise counting numbers forwards and backwards to 10 and beyond. To find what number is missing from a number line. To recognise numbers, order numbers, count objects. Patterns both in nature, around us and create our own. Shapes: square, rectangle, triangle, circle. Understand vocabulary eg big/small, tall/short , fast /slow. Vocabulary of position: under, over, in front of, behind, next to.

Science and Technology - Patterns in nature, look at the Seasons, where rain comes from. Water ice/glaciers, freezing, melting, steam. Rainbow colours

Expressive Arts – Use art, music and dance to celebrate the key dates of the Spring celebrations.

Humanities –Exploring the different celebrations of this time of year including Shrove Tuesday, St. Davids Day, Chinese New Year, Holi, Eid, St Patrick, Mothering Sunday, Easter.



#### How you can help your child at home...

- Taking shoes and socks off and putting them on again all by themselves.
- Pulling underwear and clothes up and down ,to use the toilet by themselves, remembering to wash their hands.
- Putting a coat on by themselves.
- Talking about the changes around them through the seasons.
- Recognising their own name.
- Talking about where they live – colour / number on the front door, patterns in the pavement outside etc
- Singing Nursery Rhymes and sharing a story at bedtime.



#### Things we need this term:

Suitable clothing for exploring inside and outside including waterproof coat (your child can put on) with hood and suitable shoes. Wellies can be brought in and put under their peg if you wish.

Every item of personal belonging to be clearly **labelled with child's name**. Please include shoes as these get muddled when we take them off.

Waterbottle (containing **only water**) and Green Bag daily. Please do not put the water bottle in the Green Bag. Please kindly refrain from sending more than the Green Bag in as we do not have storage for rucksacks and your child only has one peg.
