Our topic this term, 'Diversity', is all about differences and what makes us unique and special. Our topic focus will be looking at different countries, cultures and celebrations which we mark and we will be exploring how we are all different. In Languages, Literacy and Communication we will be learning about Floella Benjamin and creating instructional writing based on recipes. In Mathematics & Numeracy we will continue to 'Beat that' with our weekly Learn Its and undertake weekly CLIC and SAFE challenges. Furthermore, we will be developing our multiplication and division skills and developing our understanding of time. In Science & Technology we will be carrying out a range of scientific investigations around sound and improving our ICT skills (particularly independence using devices). In Health & Well-being we will be undertaking gymnastics activities and further developing our PSHE skills with weekly Jigsaw sessions around dreams and goals and health. In Humanities, we will be learning all about different foods from around the world, the climate and different cultures. In Expressive Arts we will be exploring dances undertaken in different countries and how to express ourselves creatively. This will all build towards an event at the end of term.


