Our topic this term is 'Diversity'.

Our topic focus will be Science and Technology. We will be finding out about significant people within the Science field and the differences they have made to our lives including different types of inventions and developments. We will be planning and taking part in a number of investigations and finding out why 'fair tests' are important. We will then share our learning with our Parents and Carers in a fun hands on Science Fair.

In Mathematics & Numeracy we will continue to 'Beat That' with our weekly Learn Its and undertake weekly CLIC and SAFE challenges. Watch out for relevant assignments on Doodle Maths, which will support our class learning.

In Literacy, Language and Communication we will be learning how to write instructions, the correct use of Imperative 'Bossy' Verbs and time connectives. We will be reading a class novel 'George's Marvellous Medicine' by Roald Dahl as a stimulus for our writing towards the end of the term.

In Welsh, we will be learning about hobbies, expressing our likes and dislikes and talking about things we may want.

In Health & Well-being we will be learning a variety of Welsh Folk Dances in preparation for St David's Day and further developing our PSHE skills with weekly Jigsaw sessions with Jigsaw Jac and talking about our Dreams and Goals.



How to support your child at home:

It would be very beneficial for your child's learning to practise reading with them every day. Please could you initial your child's reading record to show they have read with you. When they have read their book, more than once, your child will be able to choose a new book from their colour band.



Pupils who are on our Accelerated Reader Scheme should also quiz on their book before changing it. These quizzes aid your child/children's comprehension and should be completed independently.

Your child may bring home high frequency words to practise. These are the words your child must read without sounding out to develop their sight vocabulary. This helps them move through the colour-bands for reading and to support their writing.




Finally, can you ensure that your child is 'doodling' at home on DoodleMaths daily for at least 5 minutes please.
