Our topic this term 'Diversity'. Our topic focus will be Science, working towards our Science Fair. We will be learning about forces, sound and electricity as well as a range of scientists past and present. In Languages, Literacy and Communication we will be looking at instructions and following the half term break, we will be reading and completing work based on 'George's Marvellous Medicine'. In Welsh, we will be learning to ask 'Wyt ti eisiau?' ('Do you want?') and 'Sawl?' ('How many?') in different contexts and across the curriculum. In Mathematics & Numeracy we will continue to 'Beat that' with our weekly Learn Its and undertake weekly CLIC and SAFE challenges. We will also be looking at shape and symmetry. In Health & Well-being we will be learning to cross the road safely with Mr Rogers and further developing our PSHE skills with weekly Jigsaw sessions with Jigsaw Jo. In Expressive Arts we will be learning a variety of Welsh dances as well as dances based on the book, 'Handa's Surprise.'



How to support your child at home:



It would be very beneficial for your child's learning to practise reading with them every day. Please could you initial your child's reading record to show they have read with you. When they have read their book, more than once, your child will be able to choose a new book from their colour band.

Pupils who are on our Accelerated Reader Scheme should also quiz on their book before changing it.

Finally, can you ensure that your child is 'doodling' at home on Doodle Maths please; Doodle Extras are set regularly, linked to class topics.
