Our topic this term will be 'Cynefin' – Me and My Community.

Health and Well Being – Keeping myself healthy at school, healthy eating and becoming more independent in my Nursery classroom. How to be a good friend and remembering 'Kind hands. Kind Feet. Kind words'

Language, Literacy and Communication - Sound recognition, letter formation, identifying initial sounds in words. We will be reciting different rhymes using actions to help us learn them. We will be greeting each other and learning how to say 'Thank you' in Welsh and English.

In Mathematics and Numeracy we will be learning – Reciting numbers forwards and backwards to 10 and beyond, using number rhymes and songs to help us. We will learning about numbers and shapes arounds us and exploring what they are.

Science and Technology - Exploring 'what happens when I.....', looking for changes around me and keeping myself safe using technology.

Expressive Arts – Exploring colour, learning and performing songs and dances that are special to me during Autumn and Winter festivals and celebrations.

Humanities – All about me, my home, my school. Autumn and Winter festivals. Finding out about families and homes.



How you can help your child at home...

- Taking shoes and socks off and putting them on again all by themselves.
- Pulling underwear and clothes up and down to use the toilet by themselves, remembering to wash their hands.
- Putting a coat on by themselves.
- Talking about the changes around them through the seasons.
- Recognising their own name.
- Talking about where they live – colour / number on the front door, patterns in the pavement outside etc
- Singing Nursery Rhymes and sharing a story at bedtime.



Things we need this term:

Suitable clothing for exploring inside and outside including waterproof coat (your child can put on) with hood and suitable shoes. Wellies can be brought in and put under their peg if you wish.

Every item of personal belonging to be clearly **labelled with child's name**. Please include shoes as these get muddled when we take them off.

Waterbottle (containing **only water**) and Green Bag daily. Please do not put the water bottle in the Green Bag. Please kindly refrain from sending more than the Green Bag in as we do not have storage for rucksacks and your child only has one peg.
