Our topic this term will be 'We re Going on a Bear Hunt' celebrating our school theme 'Lles', 'Fun and Laughter'.

Health and Well Being – Keeping myself healthy at school, healthy eating and becoming more independent in my Nursery classroom. Dressing for the summer weather. Remembering to be 'Ready, Respectful, Safe'. Moving On and coping with changes.

Language, Literacy and Communication - Sound recognition, letter formation, blending sounds to make words, high frequency words. Name writing. We will be greeting each other and learning how to say 'Thank you' in Welsh and English. We will be learning to ask for things in Welsh and use new Welsh vocabulary we learn. We will be talking about the weather in Welsh and English

Mathematics and Numeracy – Reciting numbers forwards and backwards to 10 in Welsh/ English, using number rhymes and songs to help us. We will learning to identify numbers and find shapes arounds us,exploring their properties. We will be buying things at our 'Café' and finding out about time and other measures.

Science and technology - Exploring 'what happens when I.....', looking for changes around me through the seasons. Using technology to make things happen. Finding out about habitats around Penarth,at the beach, in the jungle and in the woods. Looking at flowers, leaves and trees.

Expressive Arts – Exploring songs connected to our topic. Looking at art and pieces of music about animals and landscapes. Making large art pieces with our group using beach and other natural materials. Creating music for our own 'Bear hunt'

Humanities – Changes in seasons and weather. Identifying land and sea features and naming them. Moving on and changes that happen to me. Festivals and celebrations in the summer.



How you can help your child at home...

- Singing nursery rhymes and counting rhymes.
- Talking about the changes around them through the seasons.
- Name writing and recognising their own name.
- Sharing books, learning sounds and words that are sent home .
- Putting on and doing up their coat by themselves.
- Looking for numbers and letters around the home and the town.

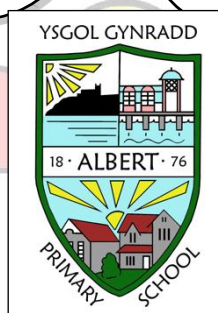
