Transfer to Secondary School September 2025

Opening Date: 20 September 2024

Closing Date: 22 November 2024

Offer Date: 03 March 2025

Application forms are available upon request for parents that are unable to access the online application portal, although this is the preferred method wherever possible as notifications are also sent via e-mail and it allows parents the opportunity to simply login and view/amend their application up until the closing date 22nd November 2024. STANWELL SCHOOL

Stanwell School became a community maintained school from September 2024. This means that the Council will be the admission authority for the school. **All applications will need to be made via the councils On-Line Admissions Process.**

As a consequence of Stanwell School's change from a Foundation School to a community maintained School from September 2024, the Council has committed to establishing transition arrangements for children in attendance at one of Stanwell's designated feeder primary schools prior to the change of status. The designated feeder schools are Albert, Evenlode, Sully and Victoria primary schools. These transition arrangements now form part of the Councils admissions policy. The Council will retain the feeder primary school link to Stanwell for those children in attendance at a designated feeder primary school during the academic year 2023/2024. **All children in the reception to year 6 age group of a designated feeder school during the 2023/2024 academic year would retain their feeder status.** The transitional arrangements and feeder link do not apply to children who enter Albert, Evenlode, Sully and Victoria primary schools from September 2024 onwards. In these cases, the Councils oversubscription criteria would apply.

The transitional arrangements will cease for the year 6 transfer process to Secondary education in September 2030 when the last child eligible under transitional arrangements leaves their feeder primary school.
