# All-Wales children's dental inspection programme



The NHS Dental Epidemiology Programme measures the extent (how many people are affected), severity (how many teeth are affected), and impact of dental disease in Wales.



Each year, the programme focusses on a different age group.

#### This school year (2024-25) we will be examining children in year 1

## Why do we look at children's oral health?

**Dental health is important.** Tooth decay can have a negative physical, social, and educational impact on children and their families.

National dental inspection have been running for more than **20 years**.

**54,235** children have taken part in **7** school year 1 surveys. In the last survey, around 1 in 3 children in Wales were seen.

Children's oral health is slowly improving but not all areas in Wales are improving at the same rate.

## The inspection helps the NHS to understand -

- · Oral health of the children in Wales
- · Trends in oral health over times
- · Differences between local areas
- · Effectiveness of prevention programmes

This will inform Welsh Government's policy on dental health and services and help NHS Wales better plan and deliver dental services in the future.

The results are shared with the **Designed to Smile** scheme to help the children that need it most.

#### You do not have to do anything yet


To use NHS resources as effectively as possible we do not always invite every child to take part. We will randomly select several children from each school.


If your child is chosen, you will soon receive a letter explaining the inspection and asking for permission to examine your child. If you give permission, please complete the form and return it to the school. Most parents who are asked decide to take part.

#### If you agree to take part

- A qualified dental team will look at your child's teeth
- ✓ All examinations will take place at school and will only take a few minutes out of their normal school day
- ✓ We will collect the minimum amount of information from you and your child, and this will be kept confidential
- We will not carry out any treatment on your child
