Our topic this term is 'Lles: Fun and Laughter'.

Our topic focus will be Expressive Arts, working towards expressing ourselves through music and drama. We will be listening to different genres of music, learning about the musical elements and song form and making our own percussion instruments. We will also be creating our own compositions to perform. In Languages, Literacy and Communication we will be looking at traditional tales and playscripts. In Welsh, we will be learning to describe how we are feeling and using phrases in Maths such as 'Faint?' (how much?). In Mathematics & Numeracy we will continue to 'Beat That' with our weekly Learn Its and undertake weekly CLIC and SAFE challenges. Watch out for relevant assignments on Doodle Maths, which will support our class learning. In Science & Technology we will be carrying out a range of scientific investigations and learning about online safety. In Health & Well-being we will be learning a variety of ball skills and further developing our PSHE skills with weekly Jigsaw sessions with Jigsaw Jo.

How to support your child at home:

It would be very beneficial for your child's learning to practise reading with them every day. Fiease could you initial your child's reading record to show they have read with you. When they have read their book, more than once, your child will be able to choose a new book from their colour band.

Pupils who are on our Accelerated Reader Scheme should also guiz on their book before changing it. These guizzes aid your child/children's comprehension and should be completed independently.

Your child may bring home high frequency words to practise. These are the words your child read without sounding out to develop their sight vocabulary. This helps them move through colour-bands for reading.



Finally, can you ensure that your child is 'doodling' at home on Doodle Maths/English regularly please.


