## ADVICE TO PARENTS & CARERS DURING ADVERSE WEATHER CONDITIONS

*Albert Primary School will endeavour to remain open during incidences of bad weather; the decision to open or close will be based on the following factors:*

- Safe access in and around the school,
- All utilities and heating system are working fully,
- Sufficient members of staff being able to attend,
- Sufficient provisions for school meals to be provided; and availability of catering staff.

**The procedures below should be followed only if snow has fallen (not if snow has been forecast).**

**You can check whether the school is open by one of the following methods, before starting your journey to school:**

- Check the school's 'X' [TWITTER] Account for a message from school.
- Please **DO NOT** bring your child along to breakfast club until you are absolutely sure the school is open. Please appreciate we will not be able to make a decision in time for the normal start time of the club.
- Ring school **after 8.00am** on 02920 707682, if you are uncertain as to whether the school is open or closed. [Please be aware that the school phone lines could be very busy at this time.]

### **If we have had significant snow but the decision has been made to open the school**

- Please bring your child to school but **stay with your child** to ensure they have accessed the building.
- Sections of the school yard will remain off-limits to parents while covered in snow – during this time please deliver and collect your child from the entrances / exits keeping on the gritted pathways that the caretaker has prepared. ***Please ensure you and your child do not stray from the cleared area.***
- Ensure the school has an up to date emergency number in order to contact you should conditions worsen during the day.
