Our work this term will include...

Our topic this term 'Diversity' is all about our differences and what makes us unique and special. Our topic focus will be looking at other countries, cultures, celebrations and how we are all different. In Languages, Literacy and Communication we will be learning about Floella Benjamin's journey to Britain, which will include descriptive and instructional writing about the Caribbean. 
